The Trade Show Training program has been developed to provide workers with the skill resources they need to succeed in the Trade Show Industry. Training classes for specific work disciplines allow for the skill development of the workers throughout their career. The classes are also designed to supply skilled, reliable labor to the Trade Show industry.

All Trade Show Trainees begin at 1st period and advance toward Trade Show Journeyman Level. In order to advance, Tradeshow Trainees must accumulate 500 hours of work and complete a minimum of 4 hrs training (one completed class) for each level of advancement. Union members are encouraged to take as many training classes as soon as possible.

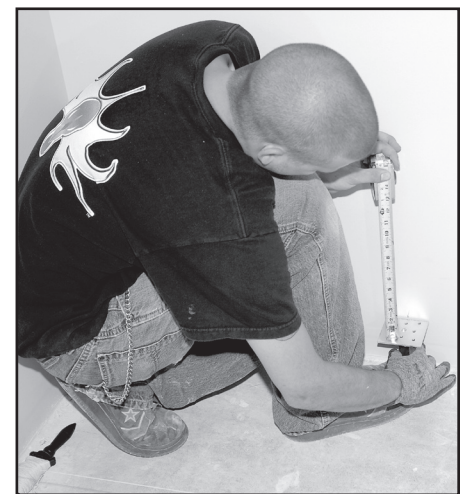
