

I'm very happy to announce that in Spokane on April 20th a new committee was approved by the Washington State Apprenticeship and Training Council. The new committee is known as the Washington State UBC JATC. This change is a monumental achievement that could not have happened without the combined and collaborative effort of hundreds of people. However, the birth of this new Apprenticeship Standards is bittersweet. With the approval of a single statewide Standards also comes the cancellation of ten Standards.
